Prevent Ranked-Choice Voting and Similar Systems

Claims of RCV Supporters Versus Factual Evidence

Supporters claim RCV: Is easy and common sense to use

In Fact:

- Exit polls show voters find the RCV voting system **confusing**, especially vulnerable populations. (Virginia, New York, Alaska, Idaho, Arlington)
- It requires **expensive** voter education and outreach and implementation software. (Utah)
- Elderly, limited English, and <u>other populations</u> are **negatively affected**. (Alaska, General)

Supporters claim RCV: Requires winners to earn majority support **In Fact:**

- There is only a majority of ballots remaining in the last round, not of all ballots initially cast.
- This is a "False" majority, and many voters are disenfranchised. (Alaska)
- Provides misleading representation of level of support.

Supporters claim RCV: May encourage new candidates to run for office

In Fact:

- Party politics could encourage a crowded ticket on the opposing side in hopes of splitting the ticket.
- Splitting the opposing party percentage boosts the **scheming party's** percentage. (Alaska)

Supporters claim RCV: Saves Time

In Fact:

- Time to **certify elections** will be increased. (New York, Virginia, New York)
- A poll of voters from an RCV election in Arlington, VA found that a majority wanted election results within 3 days of an election; this is impractical for RCV elections.
- Tabulating the ranked votes requires waiting until all mail-in ballots are ready to be counted.

Supporters claim RCV: Saves Money

In Fact:

- Necessary changes to voting machines, software and voter education are **costly**. (Utah)
- Education about a **new voting method** will need to be extensive and ongoing.
- Localities bear the cost. (NY spent \$15M on their education campaign)
- Localities that institute ranked-choice voting typically spend more on elections.
- Supporters attempt to hide costs associated by picking up the tab. (Utah)

Supporters claim RCV: Tallying logic is simple

In Fact:

- Algorithms will be required to calculate **redistribution of votes**. (Post, Alameda)
- Hand audits will be nearly impossible in all but the most limited races. (Wyoming)
- Centralized counting location needed for cross jurisdictional precinct vote tabulation.
